When you join Preschool Promise

- You may apply for tuition assistance to help reduce the cost of Preschool or to get help paying your co-pay if your Preschool isn't already free.
- Your child will receive a free book every month during the school year.
- Your child will receive a free Play Box of learning materials sent to your home every quarter.
- Your child and 1 family member will get a Preschool Promise t-shirt.
- You will receive 3 text messages per week on how to help your child keep learning at home.
- Your child will receive a monthly postcard with a fun activity, and we'll share tips about getting your child ready for Kindergarten.
- Your child will receive a birthday card and treat, and a free one-day pass for up to 6 people for the Boonshoft Museum of Discovery.

10/1/17 to 9/30/18 4-year-old	Montgomery County resident, including DPS	Eligible to apply
10/1/18 to 9/30/19 3-year-old	Reside in DPS/City of Dayton boundaries	Eligible to apply
10/1/18 to 9/30/19 3-year-old	DOES NOT reside in DPS/City of Dayton	NOT eligible to apply
10/1/19 to Present	N/A	NOT eligible to apply
